learned APP for the State.

The instant application for anticipatory bail has been filed by the petitioners apprehending their arrest in connection with Sikandra P.S. Case no. 299 of 2021 instituted for the offence under Sections 341, 323, 354, 504, 506, & 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

As per allegation in the FIR, when the informant sitting outside of her house, the accused persons including petitioners started abusing and assaulting her. It is further alleged that they tried to outrage the modesty of the informant.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners



has submitted that petitioners are innocent and have committed no offence. The petitioners have falsely been implicated in this case due to enmity and dispute of taken insurance policy by the husband of the informant. There is case and counter case between the parties. They have got no criminal antecedent.

Learned APP appearing for the state has opposed the prayer of anticipatory bail.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and in the facts and circumstances of the case as stated above, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioners on bail. The petitioners are directed to surrender in the Court below within a period of four weeks from today and in the event of their arrest or surrender in connection with Sikandra P.S. Case no. 299 of 2021, he will be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st, Class, Jamui subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
