Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to remove defect(s), as pointed out by the office, if any, within a period of four weeks from today.

This application for anticipatory bail arises out of Chhauradano P.S. Case No. 260 of 2021 for the offence punishable under Sections 272, 273, 308, 420, 188/34 of the Indian Penal Code and under Section 30(a), 32, 41(1) of the Bihar Prohibition & Excise (Amendment) Act, 2018.

Considering the fact that the recovery of illicit liquor is from the public place and the petitioners have clean antecedent, this anticipatory bail application is allowed.

Let the petitioners, above named, in the event of



their arrest/surrender within four weeks from today in the Court below, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Special Judge, Excise Court No. 2, Motihari, East Champaran, in connection with Chhauradano P.S. Case No. 260 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
