APP for the State.

The instant application for anticipatory bail has been filed by the petitioner apprehending his arrest in connection with Sakatpur P.S. Case no. 54 of 2021 instituted for the offence under Sections 341, 323, 354(B), 379, 308, 504 and 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Prosecution story relates to abuse and assault to the informant and his wife by the petitioner and other co-accused persons as a result of which informant sustained head injury.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. There is unexplained delay of four days in lodging the FIR, which falsify the prosecution story. Both



parties have received injuries in the alleged free fight. From perusal of the medical report, it appears that doctor has opined the nature of injury received by the informant is simple, which is annexed as Annexure-5 to the petition.

Learned APP appearing for the State has opposed the prayer of Bail.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and in the facts and circumstances of the case as stated above, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The petitioner is directed to surrender in the Court below within a period of four weeks from today and in the event of his arrest or surrender in connection with Sakatpur P.S. Case no. 54 of 2021, he will be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned CJM, Darbhanga subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
