5 20-06-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

Petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Section 392 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that petitioner is not named in the FIR. The name of petitioner has come in this case during the course of investigation in the confessional statement of one, Raju Kumar in connection with some other case. No incriminating article has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. Stolen articles and Scorpio has been recovered from the possession of Raju Kumar. Petitioner has got clean antecedent.

Learned counsel appearing for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail.



Considering the facts of the case and clean antecedent of the petitioner, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest/ surrender within a period of six weeks from today shall be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Judicial Magistrate, 1st class, Nawada in connection with Rajouli PS case No.15/2020, subject to conditions laid down u/s 438(2) of the Cr. P. C.
