2 20-12-2022 After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to challenge the order dated 08.11.2021 passed by the District Arms Magistrate, Nalanda at Bihar Sharif, whereby and whereunder the application of the petitioner for grant of arms license has been rejected, by filing appropriate appeal.
