2 24-08-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP
for the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes to remove
the defects within four weeks of resumption of normal court
proceedings. In the eventuality of non-removal of defects within
stipulated period, office will place the matter before the Bench.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered
for the offence punishable under section 147, 148, 149, 307,
354, 379, 506 of IPC.

Allegedly, the petitioner alongwith other accused persons
assaulted the wife of the informant and when the family
members of informant came to rescue her, the accused persons
further assaulted the informant's side by several weapons due to



which they sustained several injuries.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence. He has been falsely implicated in this case due to dirty village politics. No such occurrence, in the manner as alleged, has ever taken place. The allegation leveled against the petitioner is not specific rather general and omnibus in nature. There is a case and counter-case between the parties. In the alleged occurrence, both sides sustained injuries and the injuries are simple in nature. There is an admitted land dispute between the parties and both sides are agnates. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent as mentioned in para-3 of the bail application.

Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, since there is a case and counter-case between the parties and the injuries are simple in nature, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is
