Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):-

- I. For issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of Mandamus for commanding and directing the respondent authorities concerned for payment of the amount of life insurance in the name of his wife Late Ramawati Devi of Rs. 50,000/- but even after her death on 21.2.2015 the amount of insurance i.e. Rs. 50,000/- + vested bonus has not been paid to the petitioner, who is husband of the deceased.
- II. For issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of mandamus for commanding and directing the respondent authorities



concerned to pay the insured amount with the statutory interest without any further delay as the aim and object of life insurance is being frustrated by not paying the same even after the death of his wife on 21.2.2015.

III. For issuance of an appropriate writ/writs, order/orders, direction/directions without any further delay for which the petitioner is entitled in accordance with law.

Learned counsel for the respondents states that the present petition has become infructuous inasmuch as in defence to the proceedings pending before this Court, without going into the legality of the petition, respondents have settled the dispute and paid the amount to the petitioner and this was so done in December, 2021/January,2022.

Statement accepted and taken on record.

Petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms reserving liberty to the petitioner to take recourse to such other remedies as are otherwise available in accordance with law, should the need so arise.
