the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the opposite party



through virtual court proceedings.

At the outset, learned Senior Counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw this anticipatory bail application in respect of petitioners no.3 and 4, namely, Prema Devi and Surendra Sharma @ Surendra Thakur respectively as they have already been arrested by the police.

Permission is granted.

Accordingly, this anticipatory bail application is dismissed as withdrawn so far as petitioners no.3 and 4 are concerned.

Learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner further seeks permission to withdraw this anticipatory bail application in respect of petitioners no.1, 6 and 9, namely, Raju Sharma, Raghavendra Sharma @ Raghvendra Kumar and Kapileshwar Sharma @ Kamlesh Sharma respectively.

Permission is granted.

Accordingly, this anticipatory bail application is dismissed as withdrawn so far as petitioners no.1, 6 and 9 are concerned.

Now this anticipatory bail application survives only against petitioners no.2, 5, 7 and 8.

After some arguments, learned Senior Counsel for the



petitioners seeks permission to withdraw this anticipatory bail application in respect of petitioners no.2, 5, 7 and 8, namely, Ramu Sharma @ Ramu Kumar, Shatrudhan Sharma, Kishan Sharma @ Kishan Kumar and Sonamati Devi @ Sonawati Devi respectively.

Permission is granted.

Accordingly, this anticipatory bail application is dismissed as withdrawn so far as petitioners no.2, 5, 7 and 8 are concerned.

However, if petitioners no.2, 5, 7 and 8, namely, Ramu Sharma @ Ramu Kumar, Shatrudhan Sharma, Kishan Sharma @ Kishan Kumar and Sonamati Devi @ Sonawati Devi surrender before the learned court below within a period of four weeks from today and seek regular bail, the learned court below shall consider their prayer for regular bail in accordance with law.
