2 24-02-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The instant application for anticipatory bail has been
filed by the petitioner apprehending his arrest in connection
with Bhargama P.S. Case no. 265 of 2019 instituted for the
offence under Sections 366(A), 363/34 of the Indian Penal
Code.

As per allegation in the FIR, victim was residing at
the house of her maternal grand-father from where she was
kidnapped by the petitioner. When the family member of the
victim girl went to the house of the petitioner for enquiry,
petitioner along with his family members have hurled abuses
upon the informant and misbehaved with them.



Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. In statement of the victim girl recorded under Section 164 Cr.P.C., she has disclosed that she was in love with the petitioner and out of her own sweet will, she has left her house and performed marriage with the petitioner and she is living with him. Victim is 18 years old and she is major.

Learned APP appearing for the State has opposed the prayer of Bail.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and in the facts and circumstances of the case as stated above, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The petitioner is directed to surrender in the Court below within a period of four weeks from today and in the event of his arrest or surrender in connection with Bhargama P.S. Case no. 265 of 2019, he will be enlarged on bail on bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate, Araria subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
