2 26-08-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition & Excise Act, 2016.

It is a case of recovery of three liters of liquor from the Radha Brick-kiln.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that only three liters of illicit liquor was recovered and petitioner has not been apprehended at the spot. Petitioner has got clean antecedent.

Learned APP appearing for the State opposed the anticipatory bail.



Considering the aforesaid submissions as well as the fact that small quantity of liquor was recovered, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge, Excise, Patna City in connection with Nadi P.S. Case No. 105 of 2022, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
