**ORAL ORDER**

2      25-08-2022      Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioners undertakes to remove the defects within four weeks of resumption of normal court proceedings. In the eventuality of non-removal of defects within stipulated period, office will place the matter before the Bench.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 307, 323, 324, 341, 379, 427, 447, 504 and 506 of the IPC.

Allegation against the petitioner no.1 is that he assaulted on the head of informant's brother by means of iron knife and petitioner no.2 along with his sons have assaulted the informant by means of iron rod and farsa on his head.



It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no offence. They have been falsely implicated in this case. No such occurrence, in the manner as alleged, has ever taken place. There is an admitted land dispute between the parties. In the alleged occurrence, both sides have sustained injuries and there is a case and counter-case between the parties. The injuries are simple in nature. Petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for bail.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, since both sides have sustained injuries, let the above named petitioners, be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/Successor Court in connection with Bibhutipur P.S. Case No.215 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
