ORAL ORDER

4 29-08-2022 The learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to

remove all the defects pointed out by the office within one

month.

None appeared on behalf of the petitioner despite
repeated calls.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Mahila P.S. Case No. 32/2020 registered for offence
punishable under sections 447, 341, 323, 493, 496, 504 and
506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

As per allegation, the petitioner developed intimacy
with prosecutrix and he had physical relationship with her. At
the pretext of marriage, he exploited sexually for four years and
ultimately he refused to marry with the informant/prosecutrix.



The matter was referred to the District Mediation Centre. The report whereof has been annexed with the record, which shows that the process of mediation became unsuccessful.

Considering the above-mentioned facts and circumstances, the petitioner does not deserve the privileges for anticipatory bail. Accordingly, his prayer for anticipatory bail is rejected.

Office shall ensure that all defects are removed by the petitioner within the stipulated time mentioned hereinabove, failing which, the matter shall be brought to the notice of this Court.
