ORAL ORDER

2 05-12-2022 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following reliefs:-

“1(I). To remove the encroachment from
Govt. land situated under Mouza-Bici
Kala, Thana No.27, Khata No. 230, Plot
No. 798 area 26 dec. and Khata No. 231,
Plot No. 794, Area 44 dec. which is Govt.
land and rasta for the purpose of



general public including petitioner, which has been encroached by the private respondents for personal use.

(II) To restrain the private respondent for creating obstruction with regard to petitioner's khatiyani land situated in Mauza-Bici Kala, Khata No. 219, Plot No. 797."

The learned counsel for the Respondent-State has pointed out that an encroachment case bearing Encroachment Case No. 25/2018-19 has already been initiated by the Circle Officer, Dinara, i.e. the respondent no.4, hence, the same will definitely be taken to its logical conclusion.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, I deem it fit and proper to dispose off the present writ petition with a direction to the respondent no.4 to conclude the proceedings of the aforesaid encroachment case, by passing the final order under Section 6(1) of the Bihar Public Land Encroachment Act, 1956, in accordance with law, and after hearing the affected parties, within a period of twelve weeks of receipt/production of a copy of this order.



The writ petition stands disposed off on the
aforesaid terms.
