2 29-03-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to
remove the defect(s), as pointed out by the Office, within a
period of four weeks.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case
registered under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 337, 338 and
302 of the Indian Penal Code.

The prosecution case, in short, is that with regard to
dispute over the construction, the accused persons assaulted the
informant and family members due to which son of informant
died.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that
the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. There is no



allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. The petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case. General and omnibus allegation has been made against the petitioner. No specific overt act is alleged against the petitioner. The F.I.R. has been instituted after three days of the occurrence.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest/surrender before the learned court below within a period of twelve weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M.- 1st Bagaha, West Champaran in connection with Ram Nagar P.S. Case No. 376/2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
