ORAL ORDER

2 06-05-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State through virtual Court proceedings.

Let the defect(s), if any, be removed within a period
of four weeks after complete start of the physical Court.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 272, 273/34 of the Indian
Penal Code read with Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and
Excise (Amendment) Act, 2018.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is in custody since 09.03.2022, charge-sheet has been
submitted and has antecedent of three cases.

Allegation is of recovery of 964 litres of liquor from
the maize field of Mahesh Mahto.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that



petitioner was not arrested from the spot and name of the petitioner transpired based on the secret information alleged to have been received by the police. Learned counsel further submits that the field from where the liquor was recovered does not belong to the petitioner. It is, thus, submitted that the petitioner came to be implicated falsely by the police based on his antecedent.

Learned A.P.P. for the State vehemently opposes the prayer for regular bail of the petitioner.

Considering the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 09.03.2022, charge-sheet has been submitted and taking into consideration the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner, above named, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court below where the case is pending in connection with Rosera P.S. Case No. 100 of 2021.
