Petitioner has prayed for following relief:-

That the present writ application is being filed for
issuance of an appropriate writ/writs, order/orders,
direction/directions particularly in the nature of
certiorari for quashing the order contained in Memo
No. 228 dated 30.03.2020 issued under the

signature of Sub-Divisional Officer, Hajipur, District
– Vaishali whereby and whereunder the license no.
07/2016 of the petitioner under Public Distribution
System has been suspended and further quashing
the order contained in Memo No. 332 dated
04.06.2020 issued under the signature of Sub-
Divisional Officer, Hajipur whereby and whereunder
the license no. 07/2016 of the petitioner under
Public Distribution System has been cancelled and
further prays to restore the license of the petitioner
forthwith.

Petitioner has approached this Court without exhausting the statutory remedy of appeal against the impugned order, as such, petitioner is granted liberty to file an appeal before the appellate authority against the order passed by the Sub-Divisional Officer, Hajipur, District- Vaishali -cum- licensing authority, and if any such appeal is filed within 4 weeks from today, the appellate authority shall condone the delay in filing the appeal and shall decide the appeal on its own merit

preferably within 8 weeks from the date of its filing.

With aforesaid liberty, the writ petition stands disposed
of.
