2 06-01-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

The matter has been taken up through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks regular bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under Section 363, 366(A), 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

As per the prosecution case, this petitioner along with other accused persons kidnapped the daughter of informant for the purpose of marriage.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the case. It is submitted that victim in her statement recorded u/s 164 of the Cr. P. C. stated that she voluntarily left her house and solemnized marriage with this petitioner. She stated her age to



be 18 years. Petitioner claims clean antecedent and is in custody since 05.02.2021 and investigation in this case is complete.

Learned counsel appearing for the State opposes the prayer for bail.

Considering the facts of the case, the period of custody of the petitioner and the statement of victim recorded u/s 164 of the Cr. P. C., let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-I, Saharsa in connection with Bangaon PS case No.104/2019.
