ORAL ORDER

6 02-02-2022 The matter has been taken up for online hearing through video conference because of COVID-19 pandemic restrictions.

Mr. Vinay Krishna Tripathy, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the Central Board of Secondary Education (for short 'the Board') has informed that this Court's order dated 23.11.2017, passed in CWJC No. 14587 of 2016 has been fully complied with and a decision has been taken to correct the petitioner's date of birth by changing it to 07.10.1994 in place of 07.10.1996. He has submitted that an



information in this regard has been sent to the concerned school where the petitioner can visit to surrender/ deposit the certificate earlier issued by the Board and whereafter fresh certificate/ documents with corrected date of birth shall be issued to him by the Board.

In view of the aforesaid statement made on behalf of the Board, the contempt proceeding is dropped.
