Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Petitioner has prayed for following relief:-

“For issuance of an appropriate writ and / or
order and/ or direction to the respondents for granting
extension of time of the project as per agreement bearing
agreement bearing agreement no. SBD No. 04/2018-19 for
the construction of Administrative Block, workshop, staff

Hostel, canteen Block, principal's Residence and vice
Principal's residence with water supply and sanitary
Installation work and Electrification work of Boy I.T.I.
Building at Dumma Hirauta in the District -Sheohar in the
year 2017-18.

The petitioner also prays for a direction to
respondents for payment of 10% cut amounting to Rs.
16,69,22L / - in the advance paid to the petitioner due to
non-extension of time of the aforesaid project.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, states that similar
petition being **C.W.J.C. No. 5332 of 2022** titled as **M/s
Hitendra Kumar Mishra Vs. the State of Bihar & Ors.** was
disposed of by this Court vide judgment dated **07.05.2022**, and
