ORAL ORDER

3 28-04-2022 The learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to

remove all the defects pointed out by the Stamp Reporter within

one month.

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and

learned APP for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest for the

offences alleged under Sections 419, 420, 467, 471 and 472 of

the Indian Penal Code, registered in connection with Sugauli

P.S.Case No. 02 of 2021.

As per allegation, some important government

documents were recovered from the house of the present

petitioner.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted

that none of the government officials have complained that the

documents in their custody was taken away by the petitioner.

He has submitted further that the petitioner runs a photocopy

shop and some persons had handed over those papers to get the



same photocopied and those were taken away by the raiding party.

The learned APP has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Considering the above facts and circumstances, let the petitioner above-named, in the event of his arrest or surrender within four weeks from the date of communication of this order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Motihari, East Champaran in connection with Sugauli P.S. Case No. 02 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr. P.C.

Office shall ensure that all defects are removed by the petitioner within the stipulated time as provided hereinabove, failing which the matter shall be brought to the notice of this Court.
