2 08-09-2022 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offence under Sections 413/414 of the Indian Penal Code.

Petitioner has been made accused in this case on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused, who was apprehended on spot with stolen motorcycle.

It is submitted on behalf of petitioner that no incriminating article has been recovered from the possession of this petitioner and he has got no concern with the alleged motorcycle, which is said to be stolen and recovered from the possession of co-accused. Petitioner claims clean antecedent.

Learned A.P.P. for the State has opposed the bail petition.



Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the above named petitioner, in the event of his arrest/surrender within a period of six weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M. 13th Saran at Chapra in connection with Manjhi P.S. Case No. 10 of 2020, subject to condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
