Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Petitioner has prayed for following relief:-

- I. To pay to the petitioner his due money to the tune of Rs. 11,99,500/- pursuant to the work done by the petitioner in connection with agreement no.19H2-2017-18 entered into on 08.11.2017 between the petitioner and the respondent no. 9.
- II. To award such interest/penal interest over the aforesaid amount as may be deemed fit and proper.
- B. For any other relief/s to which the petitioner is found entitled to.

After the matter was heard for some time, finding the Court not in favour of the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, learned counsel for the petitioner, under instructions, states that the petitioner will be content if the petitioner is permitted to withdraw the present petition, with liberty to initiate appropriate proceedings before the appropriate forum and to take recourse to such other alternate remedies which are equally efficacious in law.

Prayer allowed.

It stands clarified that all issues of fact and law are left open to be agitated before the competent authority.

The petition is disposed of as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.

Interlocutory application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
