Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to remove defect(s), as pointed out by the office, if any, within a period of four weeks from today.

This application for anticipatory bail arises out of Katoriya P.S. Case No. 60 of 2020 registered for the offence punishable under Sections 308, 323, 341, 504, 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw this bail application on behalf of petitioner no.3, above named.

Accordingly, this bail application is dismissed as withdrawn as against petitioner no.3, above named.



So far as the bail of petitioner nos. 1 and 2 is concerned, the same is allowed considering the fact that the occurrence has taken place on account of trivial issue and the petitioner nos. 1 and 2 have clean antecedent.

Accordingly, let the petitioner nos. 1 and 2, above named, in the event of their arrest/surrender within four weeks from today in the Court below, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Banka, in connection with Katoriya P.S. Case No. 60 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
