2 08-08-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Excise Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a person with clean antecedent and allegation is of recovery of 510 litre of liquor concealed in straw at Sarai.

The learned counsel for the petitioner was not apprehended from the spot as such nothing was recovered from his conscious possession, it is next submitted that he was implicated falsely by local chawkidar with whom he is on an inimical term, it is also submitted that even the alleged place of recovery does not belong to the petitioner.



Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner above-named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned trial court within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 2,000/- (Rupees Two Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Mufasil P.S. Case No. 85 of 2022 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
