This application is for modification of order dated



02.03.2022 passed in Cr. Appeal (SJ) No.1501 of 2021, whereby the petitioners were allowed anticipatory bail in connection with Bausi P.S. Case No.87 of 2020. However, the petitioners could not furnish bail bond within time.

For substantial justice, further four weeks' time is allowed to the petitioners to furnish bail bonds subject to condition that each of the petitioners shall deposit Rs.2,000/- (Rupees Two Thousand) in the Victim Compensation Fund and shall produce the receipt of the same at the time of furnishing of the bail bonds.

Accordingly, the application stands allowed.
