Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):-

That the present Public Interest Litigation has been filed for direction to the respondents for allotting Govt. Land for the purpose of Gaushala (Gaurakshni) at Sherghat Block in the District of Gaya as petitioner represented for several years and communication in the Department of the respondents also done from one and other but till date the same is not allowed and/or any other order/orders as your lordships may deem fit and proper under the circumstances of the case.

Shri Sajid Salim Khan, learned Standing Counsel No. 25, states that there is adequate provision of taking care of stray cows at Sherghati, Gaya. He further clarifies that there is a Gawshala at Sherghati, Gaya and the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Committee is fully functional. As such, the present petition needs to be closed.

Despite repeated calls, none has entered appearance on behalf of the petitioner.

As such, we close these proceedings reserving liberty to the petitioner to highlight the grievances, if any, with the appropriate authority as also approach this Court, should the need so arise subsequently.

The present petition stands disposed of in the
