This application for grant of anticipatory bail arises out of Tajpur Halai O.P. P.S. Case No. 65 of 2022 registered for the offence under Section 30(a)/41(i)(ii) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act and Section 272/273 of the Indian Penal Code.

The petitioner has antecedent of similar nature.

In view of the fact that *prima facie* a case under the Excise Act, is made out against the petitioner, this application for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is not maintainable in view of Full Bench decision of this Court rendered in the case of *Ram Vinay Yadav vs. The State of Bihar reported in 2019(2)*

Accordingly, this anticipatory bail application is
dismissed as not maintainable.
