Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):-

i. For issuance of writ / writs, order / orders to grant relief to set aside and quash the order dated 20.01.2022 issued by District Legal Department, Collectorate, Munger for Physical Possession of property which was scheduled to be done by respondents.

ii. For a direction to respondent no.1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 & 7 for not taking any coercive action against the petitioner.

iii. For supply of statement of account till date of account no. 38390600000090 in the name of the loanee / petitioner Manohar Kumar Mandal.

iv. For grant of relief to the petitioner specifically because the petitioner is in deprived condition and is great need of economical survival.

v. For any order / orders, direction / directions as this Hon'ble Court deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case.

In view of the fact that Debts Recovery Tribunal is now functional learned counsel for the petitioner, under instruction, seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to take recourse to such other appropriate remedies, as are otherwise available, in accordance with law.
