Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):-

1. That the instant application is being preferred for issuance of order(s), direction(s), writ(s) particularly in the nature of writ of mandamus to the respondent authorities to make payment of the admitted contractual dues as follows:-
 - (i) The balance amount of Rs 643987 (Six lacks, forty three thousand nine hundred eighty seven rupees) against performing work of Ballot box , repair , spare parts, painting (Spray) oiling and greacing etc under the supervision of B.D.O by the order of District Panchayat Raj Officer vide letter no-176-Laheriasarai, dated 09.02.2016.
 - (ii) To further impose an interest of 20 % per annum on the above said amount from the date of its payment till the date of its actual payment.

After the matter was heard for some time, finding the Court not in favour of the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, learned counsel for the petitioner, under instructions, states that the petitioner will be content if the petitioner is permitted to withdraw the present petition, with liberty to initiate appropriate proceedings before the appropriate forum and to take recourse to such other alternate remedies which are equally efficacious in law.

Prayer allowed.

It stands clarified that all issues of fact and law are

left open to be agitated before the competent authority.

The petition is disposed of as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.

Interlocutory application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
