APP for the State.

The instant application for anticipatory bail has been filed by the petitioner apprehending his arrest in connection with Rajgir P.S. Case no. 256 of 2021 instituted for the offence under Sections 341, 323, 308, 504, 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Prosecution story relates to abuse and assault to the informant and his family members by the petitioners and other co-accused persons while informant was sitting at his house.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. There is case and counter case between the parties. Both parties have received injuries in the alleged



occurrence. They have got no criminal antecedent. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that similarly situated co-accused persons has already been granted bail.

Learned APP appearing for the State has opposed the prayer of Bail.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and in the facts and circumstances of the case as stated above, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The petitioner is directed to surrender in the Court below within a period of four weeks from today and in the event of his arrest or surrender in connection with Rajgir P.S. Case no. 256 of 2021, he will be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned CJM, Nalanda at Biharsharif subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
