2 11-10-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 341, 323, 354, 308, 504 and 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegedly, it is a case of assault upon the daughter of the informant due to which she sustained injuries.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that there is case and counter case between the parties and both parties have sustained injuries, as alleged, in separate occurrence. Petitioner has clean antecedent.

Learned APP appearing for the State opposed the anticipatory bail.



Considering the aforesaid submissions, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of ACJM-I, Munger in connection with G.R. No. 1473 of 2021 arising out of Nayaramnagar P.S. Case No. 100 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
