ORAL ORDER

2 11-04-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to
remove the defect(s), as pointed out by the Office, within a
period of four weeks.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case
registered under Sections 341, 323, 354, 379, 504, 506 and 34 of
the Indian Penal Code.

The prosecution case, in short, is that the petitioner
forced the informant to make physical relation with him and
also assaulted her.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that
the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. There is no
allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged against the



petitioner. The petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case. The case has been instituted after six days of the alleged occurrence. The delay has not been explained. Vide Annexure-2 to the present application, a case has been instituted by the petitioner also against the informant's side. Both the parties are agnates. The offences are triable by the Magistrate.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest/surrender before the learned court below within a period of twelve weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned S.D.J.M., Pupri, Sitamarhi in connection with Nanpur P.S. Case No. 17/21, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
