ORAL ORDER

2 11-08-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

Let the defect(s), if any, as pointed out by the
office, be removed within four weeks.

The petitioner is in custody in connection with
Hajipur Sadar Town P.S. Case No. 244 of 2022 under sections
420, 413, 414/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

As per the allegation, the police on patrolling duty
reached Surya I.T.I. College Jadhua when they saw two persons
riding a motorcycle. They were intercepted, tried to escape,
were finally apprehended and upon asking for the documents
relating to the motorcycle failed to provide any valid paper.
Accordingly, seizure list was prepared and the accuseds were
arrested.



Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the said alleged act, he has already suffered a lot by being in custody since 22.3.2022 (as stated in para-10 of the bail application) and has been implicated only because he has criminal antecedent.

Taking into account the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 22.3.2022 and the charge-sheet stands submitted, this Court is inclined to grant him the privilege of bail.

Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of learned C.J.M., Vaishali at Hajipur, in connection with Hajipur Town P.S. Case No. 244 of 2022 subject to the following conditions:

(i) one of the bailors should be the family members of the petitioner, who shall provide official document to show his/her bona fide;

(ii) the petitioner shall appear on each and every date before the Trial Court and failure to do so for two consecutive dates without plausible reasons will entail his cancellation of bail by the Trial Court itself;

(iii) he shall appear before the concerned police station every fortnight for next six months to mark his



presence;

(iv) the petitioner shall desist from committing any criminal offence again, failing which the State shall be at liberty to take steps for cancellation of his bail bonds.

With the aforesaid observations, the bail application is allowed.
