2 18-08-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the
learned APP for the State.

Let the defect(s) be removed within four weeks of the
complete start of the physical Court in normal course.

The petitioners are in judicial custody in connection
with Chainpur P.S. Case No.47 of 2014 instituted under Sections
324/34,307 of the Indian Penal Code and 27 of the Arms Act.

As per the allegation in the FIR, which was lodged in
2014, the informant has alleged that while his brother was
attending the call of nature, it is alleged that all the named
accuseds including the petitioner herein opened fire which
caused injury on his hand and chest. Further allegation is that
they again resorted to firing which hit his leg. He submits that



despite that indiscriminate firing, fortunately he saved himself.

As stated above the matter is of 2014 and it was only in the month of February, 2022 (25.02.2022) that the petitioner came into judicial custody.

Considering the fact that he evaded arrest for eight long years despite being named in the FIR thus hampering the progress of the Trial, has criminal antecedent, this Court is not inclined to grant the privilege of bail to the petitioner, which is accordingly rejected.

The Trial court is directed to expedite the trial within and conclude the same within a period of one year in view of the fact the matter is of 2015.
