ORAL ORDER

2 22-06-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the offences punishable under Section 307 of the Indian Penal Code read with Section 27 of the Arms Act.

The present application has been filed in terms of the liberty granted to the petitioner by order dated 16.02.2022 in Cr. Misc. No. 54583 of 2021 to renew his prayer for bail after framing of charge.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that charges against the petitioner have been framed on 01.04.2022 as is evident from page 21 of the bail application.

Since the charges against the petitioner have been framed, the petitioner, above named, is directed to be released



on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court below where the case is pending in connection with Vaishali P.S. Case No. 214 of 2018 corresponding to S.T. No. 131 of 2022, subject to the condition that if the learned court below comes to a conclusion that the petitioner after his release is trying to delay the trial in any manner then in that event the learned court below shall forthwith cancel the bail bond of the petitioner by recording reasons.
