ORAL ORDER

2 01-11-2022 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following reliefs:-

“1(I). For issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus commanding and directing to the respondents to initiate an encroachment proceeding under the Bihar public Land Encroachment Act against the persons who have encroached the Government Land (Aam Gairmajarua Land) public road situated under Mauza Katarmala, thana no. 245, Tauzi No. 654, Khata No. 607, Plot No. 1278 comes under the jurisdiction of circle office Dandari, Begusarai.



(II). For issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus commanding and directing the respondents to conclude the encroachment proceeding under the Bihar Public Land Encroachment Act earliest as possible earlier and remove the encroachment from the Government Land (Aam Gairmajarua Land) public road situated under Mauza Katarmala, thana no. 245, tauzi no. 654, khata no. 607, plot no. 1278 comes under the jurisdiction of Circle Office Dandari, Begusarai.

At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the Circle Officer, Dandari, Begusarai for redressal of his aforesaid grievance.

Liberty so sought is granted.

It is needless to state that in case the petitioner approaches the Circle Officer, Dandari, Begusarai by filing appropriate petition under the provisions of the Bihar Public Land Encroachment Act, 1956, within a period of four weeks from today, the same shall be considered, in accordance



with law and after hearing the affected parties,
appropriate orders shall be passed thereon,
forthwith.

The writ petition stands disposed off on the
aforesaid terms.
