3 26-04-2022 The petitioners have a grievance against the action of the respondents of demand of licence fee with increment from retrospective effect, which, according to the petitioners, is in contravention of relevant guidelines issued by the Railway Board in relation to commercial plots settled in their favour.



After some argument, learned counsel for the petitioners, seeks permission to withdraw this writ application with a liberty to approach the General Manager, East Central Railway, Zonal Office, Hajipur, raising the grievance as has been raised in the writ petition.
