following relief:-

“01.(I). For direction to the State Director, Khadi and Village Industries Commission, State Office, Patna to conduct audit of godown of Vaishali Khadi Gram Udyog Sangh, Hajipur for the period 2014-15 and 2015-16 and submit report at the earliest clearly stating whether there has been any misappropriation/defalcation.”

After some arguments, the learned counsel for the
petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however,



seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other
alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law.

Liberty so sought is granted.

The writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
