(II) And further be pleased grant other relief/ reliefs as the petitioner is entitled for.”

4. Petitioner’s grievance is pending consideration before the concerned respondent including District Magistrate, Nalanda. Therefore, the District Magistrate, Nalanda is hereby directed to take note of grievance of the petitioner and redress the same after giving due opportunity of hearing to 7th respondent- Nitu Kumari. The above exercise shall be completed within a period of three months from the date of receipt of this order.
