ORAL ORDER

2 11-08-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

Let the defect(s), if any, be removed within a period of
four weeks.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered
for the offences punishable under Sections 272, 273, 414/34 of the
Indian Penal Code read with Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition
and Excise (Amendment) Act, 2018.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner has antecedent of one case.

Allegation is of recovery of three stolen motorcycles
from the straw house of the petitioner and 30 litre of liquor from
the straw house of Smt. Devi @ Sunita Devi.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that



petitioner was not arrested from the spot, as such, nothing was recovered from his conscious possession. He further submits that as far as recovery of alleged motorcycle is concerned, the same does not belong to the petitioner.

Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner above-named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Raghapur P.S. Case No. 286 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C. and further one of the bailors of the petitioner shall be the father (Bindeshwar Ray) of the petitioner.
