ORAL ORDER

- 2 07-03-2022 Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw this application with a liberty to prefer an appeal against the impugned order 13.07.2020, whereby the Sub-Divisional Officer-cum-Licensing Authority, Bikramganj under the provision of the Bihar Targeted Public Distribution System (Control) Order, 2016 {in short ‘(Control) Order’} has cancelled the petitioner’s license to run a PDS shop.



Considering the submission made on behalf of the petitioner, this application is dismissed as withdrawn with a liberty to the petitioner to prefer an appeal before the appropriate authority. if an appeal is preferred within four weeks from today with an application seeking condonation of delay, the Appellate Authority shall be required to consider the same in accordance with law, keeping in mind the fact that petitioner was pursuing his remedy before this Court by filing present writ application.

The Court further expects the Appellate Authority to decide petitioner's appeal as expeditiously as possible and within the period prescribed for disposal of an appeal under (Control) Order.
