ORAL ORDER

2 11-08-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 30(a), 36 and 40 of the Bihar Excise Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a person with clean antecedent and allegation is of recovery of 75 liters of spirit from three motorcycles and from the semi-constructed house of Ranbijay Sah.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was not apprehended from the spot as such nothing was recovered from his conscious possession and he came to be implicated as he is the owner of one of the motorcycles from which 10 liters spirit is alleged to have been recovered, it is next



submitted that petitioner had given his motorcycle to a friend and as such was completely unaware that the same would be misused for such an illegal purpose.

Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner above-named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 2,000/- (Rupees Two Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Panapur P.S. Case No. 238 of 2021 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
