2 16-09-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and

learned APP for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a

case registered for the offences punishable under

Sections 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition & Excise Act.

There is recovery of 765 litres of Indian made

Foreign Liquor from a maize field.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the

petitioner that petitioner was not apprehended from the

spot. Nothing was recovered from the conscious

possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has no

concern with the seized illicit liquor or the place of



recovery. A statement has been made in para 3 of the petition that petitioner is accused in three other cases, out of which, two cases are of similar nature.

Considering the fact that petitioner is accused in three other cases out of which, two cases are of similar nature, this Court is not inclined to grant privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the petition is disposed off with a liberty to the petitioner to surrender before learned Court below and pray for regular bail. The learned Court below may consider the prayer for regular bail of the petitioner, keeping in view the facts discussed above and without being prejudiced by the order of this Court.
