2 22-06-2022 Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):

“i. For issuance of an
appropriate writ in the nature of
CERTIORARI for quashing the tender no.
2/2022 dated 21-04-2022 issued under
the signature of Respondent No. 4 in as
much as condition no. 4 under heading



other conditions of the said tender on the ground that said condition is entirely illegal and arbitrary.

ii. For issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of MANDAMUS commanding and directing the Respondent Authorities to allow the petitioner firm to participate in said tender no. 2/2022 by making adequate arrangements.

iii. For issuance of any other appropriate writ/writs, order/orders, direction/directions for which the writ petitioner is entitled under the facts and circumstances of the case.”

After the matter was heard for some time, finding the Court not in favour of the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, learned counsel for the petitioner, under instructions, states that the petitioner shall be content if the petitioner is permitted to withdraw the present petition, with liberty to initiate appropriate proceedings before the appropriate forum i.e. respondent No. 4, namely The District Magistrate, Saran at Chapra and to take recourse to such other alternate remedies which are equally efficacious in law.

Prayer allowed.



The petition is disposed of as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.

Interlocutory application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
