2 20-09-2022 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offence under Section 307 & other allied sections of the Indian Penal Code.

As per F.I.R., both petitioners are alleged to have assaulted informant and his son.

It is submitted on behalf of petitioners that due to petty dispute, a simple *Maarpit* took place between informant and petitioners. The injury sustained by the informant is simple in nature. The petitioners have got clean antecedent.

Learned A.P.P. for the State has opposed the bail petition.



Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the above named petitioners, in the event of their arrest/surrender within a period of six weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned J.M. 1st Class, Gaya in connection with Tekari P.S. Case No. 370 of 2021, subject to condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
