2 04-01-2022 Heard learned counsel for the parties through video conferencing.

The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in a case registered under section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

As per the prosecution case, 9 litres of country liquor is said to have been recovered from the possession of the petitioner.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that no incriminating article has been recovered from his possession. He has been falsely implicated in the case because of his antecedents. He is in custody since 25.1.2021 and chargesheet has been submitted in the case.

Heard learned A.P.P. for the State.



Having heard learned counsel for the parties and taking into consideration the facts of the case together with the petitioner having remained in custody for over 11 months, the Court directs the petitioner to be enlarged on bail in connection with Excise Case no.89 of 2021 (arising out of Chand P.S. Case no.10 of 2021) on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/ (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Sessions Judge 2nd -cum-Special Judge, Kaimur at Bhabua.
