ORAL ORDER

2 12-10-2022 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 379 and 414/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegedly, it is a case of theft of a motorcycle.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that the name of the petitioner came into light on the basis of apprehended co-accused Md. Sufiyan and petitioner has not been apprehended at the spot and no stolen motorcycle was recovered from his possession.

Learned APP appearing for the State opposed the anticipatory bail.



Considering the aforesaid submissions, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned CJM, Araria in connection with Raniganj P.S. Case No. 341 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
