During pendency of the trial of the case against the petitioner now this application has been filed for a direction that this court should direct the concerned authorities (not impleaded in the writ application) to take action against the respondents who are Superintendent of Police, Central Bureau of Investigation and the Inspector of Police, Central Bureau of
