2 07-01-2022 Heard learned counsel for the parties through video conferencing.

The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in a case registered under section 30(a) and 41(i) and (ii) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

As per the prosecution case, 300 litres of liquor is said to have been recovered from a tempo and the petitioner along with one another were taken into custody.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that no incriminating article has been recovered from the petitioner's possession who has been falsely implicated in the case. He is in custody since 19.2.2021 and has no criminal antecedent.

Heard learned A.P.P. for the State.



Having heard learned counsel for the parties and taking into consideration the facts of the case, the petitioner having remained in custody for over 10 months and not having any criminal antecedent, the Court directs the petitioner to be enlarged on bail in connection with Chapra Town P.S. Case no.109 of 2021 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/ (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional District and Sessions Judge II-cum-Special Judge, Excise, Saran at Chapra.
