3 22-09-2022 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offence under Sections 341, 323, 324, 308, 504, 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is submitted on behalf of petitioners that due to land dispute between the parties, the scuffle took place. Specific accusation of assault is against co-accused Raj Kumar Singh and Sujit Kumar Singh. So far as these petitioners are concerned, there is general and omnibus allegation.

Learned A.P.P. for the State has opposed the bail petition.



Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the above named petitioners, in the event of their arrest/surrender within a period of six weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned C.J.M., Katihar in connection with Manihari P.S. Case No. 213 of 2021, subject to condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
